

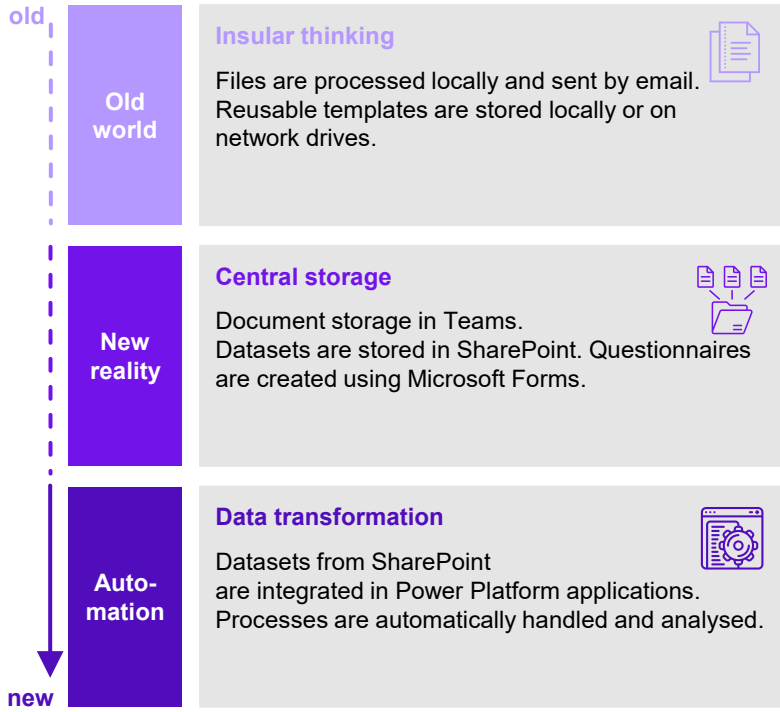

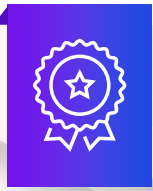
Through the integration of Power Apps, Power Automate and Power BI, **document management, document creation, interactive dashboards, queries** and much more can be automated.

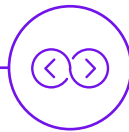

NDA generator

The NDA generator is a self-service for the legal department's internal customers. Employees are guided through a questionnaire, on the basis of which an NDA is created, signed and released within the solution. Special cases can be automatically forwarded to the legal department by the application. This allows employees without a legal background to create NDAs quickly, easily and securely based on the latest template.



KPI Dashboard

The KPI dashboard is a central dashboard for leadership, which is used to access and analyse the key performance indicators of the legal department. A KPI dashboard can either be manually populated with data or it can be linked to existing systems and report live actual data. Evidence-based management creates transparency regarding the data of the legal department.



Law firm/Document management

Instead of storing files in folder structures or data in Excel files, all documents are consolidated, recorded and analysed in SharePoint. The recorded documents form the basis for automated reports and emails or for visualisations using Power BI. Open tasks are not forgotten, as reminders and escalations are automatically sent to all assigned users.



Gifts & Invitation Checker

The Gifts & Invitation Checker is a self-service for all employees who are in contact with other companies. It checks permissibility for accepting gifts and invitations. Special cases are automatically forwarded to experts from the Compliance Team. A direct recommendation for action and the low-threshold nature of the solution result in a high review rate.
